

Mr. Deshal de Mel

Desal de Mel is an economist who works for the Ministry of Finance of Sri Lanka as Economic Advisor. He was previously attached to the Hayleys Group, where he served as Senior Economist and was subsequently involved in setting up Hayleys Global Beverages, the Group's tea extracts manufacturing company.

Mr. de Mel previously worked for the Institute of Policy Studies of Sri Lanka. His research has been published in a number of books and journals. Along with policy research, Mr. de Mel also represented the Government of Sri Lanka in inter-governmental trade negotiations. He at present serves on the National Negotiation Team for Sri Lanka's ongoing trade negotiations.

Mr. de Mel has a degree in Philosophy, Political Science and Economics from the University of Oxford and completed his Masters in International Political Economy at the London School of Economics.

Mr. de Mel is a Commissioner of the Securities & Exchange Commission of Sri Lanka. He previously served on the Board of Directors of Sampath Bank PLC as a Non-Executive Director for 5 years. He was also Chairman of SC Securities (Pvt Ltd) and served on the Board for 3 years. Mr. de Mel is a member of the Board of Directors of the Centre for Poverty Analysis (CEPA). He was the LMD economic columnist during the period 2013-2016.
